Spine Academy Meeting 2022: International expert forum on spine surgery at Ulrich Medical

35 participants and 18 speakers from 13 countries attended the Spine Academy Meeting in Ulm, Germany, from July 6 to 8, which was held as part of the Ulrich Medical Academy. This year, for the eighth time, the medical technology manufacturer provided a high-quality exchange of experience with internationally renowned experts.

After two years of forced pause due to the pandemic, the CME-certified event took place in presence again. Renowned spine specialists from around the world led participants through case discussions and hands-on workshops.
